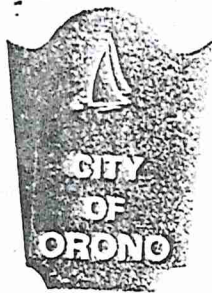
To Whom it May Concern:

Dear Mr. Bloom

I have been contacted by Kevin Johnson representing Camp Teko at the above subject property. He is requesting that another building be connected to city sewer.

I am requesting that you review this letter and notify me if additional SAC Charges are to be charged.

The following buildings are located on the property:

BUILDING -A- Dining hall, Kitchen with living unit.

The dining hall is used during the spring, summer and fall months and about 2-3 days per month during the winter months. The living unit is used year around, in the basement there are sleeping quarters for 20 occupants. This structure is hooked to city sewer already.

BUILDING -B- Is used for sleeping quarters (20 occupants) and some meetings. This structure is used during spring, summer and fall months and 2 or 3 days a month during the winter. This is the structure they propose to hook up to city sewer.

BUILDING -C- Consist of five cabins 10 occupants per cabin, these are used in spring, summer and fall months for sleeping only. Satellites are used during this time. There are no restroom facilities in the building.

BUILDING -D- is a cabin which is uses for sleeping purposes only during spring, summer fall and approximately 2-3 days per month during the winter. The structure has no sanitary facilities in it.




The camp is used spring, summer and fall and about 2-3 days a month during the winter, except the year around living unit in Building (A).

Our file shows we have collected one SAC Charge, could you please let me know how many more SAC's should be charged.

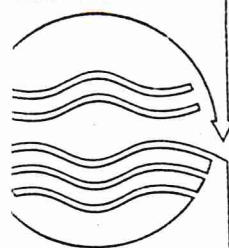

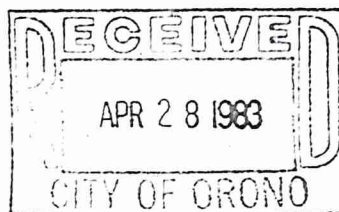
