


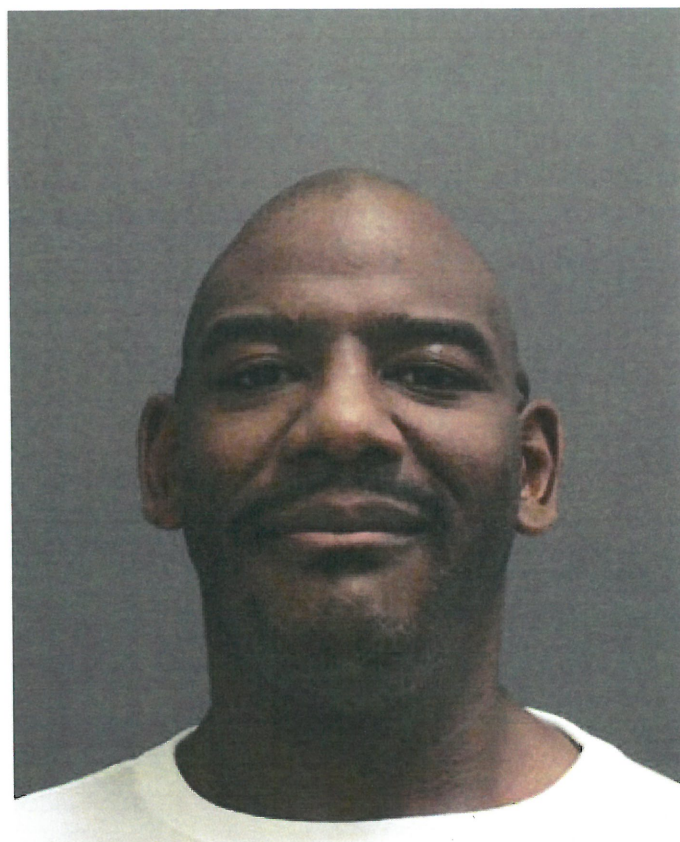


Predatory offender in Tonka Bay

A level three predatory offender is living in Tonka Bay, according to South Lake Minnetonka Police Department officials.

Christopher Obrien Bogan, 31, was convicted of engaging in sexual contact, including penetration, with a 13-year-old girl. According to information from the Minnesota Department of Corrections, Bogan lured the girl, who did not know him, through manipulation and "gained compliance through physical force."

Bogan served his sentence and was released in 2010. The public is being informed because he has moved to the vicinity of Tonka Bay Road and Woodduck Lane in Tonka Bay.

South Lake Minnetonka Police will hold a public meeting about Bogan at 6 p.m. Wednesday, Aug. 17 at the Southshore Center, located at 5735 Country Club Road in Shorewood.

Police officials may not direct Bogan about where he may live, work or go to school, according to a notification from the department. It also notes that officials do not want to increase fear in the community, but they believe that "an informed public is a safer public."
